Stopping the Violence

LACASA offers a variety of different services for teens who are beginning to use violence within their homes and the community. The goal of the program and the agency is to stop the violence and promote equality in the teen's current and future relationships.

Program Goals

- 1 To keep others safe.
- 2 To stop the violence.
- 3 To assist the teens to be responsible for their behavior.
- 4 To explore non-violence and non-controlling ways of relating.

Services Available for Teens

Finding Safe Options

A four week long prevention educational group for teenagers age 13-17 who are beginning to choose violence.

SAFE

Safe Alternatives For Everyone

An eight week long prevention educational group for teenagers age 13-17 who are beginning to choose violence, but also have a history of other violent behavior.

Youth Alternatives to Violence

An eighteen week long prevention educational group for teenagers age 13-17 who have witnessed domestic violence in the home and are beginning to repeat the cycle of violence by being physically and/or verbally abusive.

Protecting Ourselves

A one time workshop for teenagers age 13-17 focusing on how to identify and prevent dangerous situations Workshop also includes information on dating violence and sexual assault.

Individual Counseling

Individual counseling sessions with the teens to address issues of violence and accountability as well as to assist teens identifying alternatives to violence.

How To Register

Please call the number below and a LACASA staff member will assist you in scheduling an appointment for an intake assessment. An intake assessment must be completed with a LACASA staff member prior to participation in any services.

An intake assessment is completed by meeting with the teen as well as a parent or guardian. The goal of this session is to gather information on the teen's personal and family history as well as gain information on behavioral issues, and prevalence of the current violence.
